He is the medical director and team physician for the Tampa Bay Lightning and serves as team physician for numerous high school teams in Pasco and Hillsborough Counties. He is an expert in minimally invasive surgery of the knee and shoulder. Procedures such as Rotator Cuff Repair, Shoulder Instability Surgery, Meniscus Surgery, and Knee Ligament Reconstruction (ACL Surgery) can be performed with almost no incision.

A leader in the treatment of Osteoarthritis of the knee, Dr. Guttentag is currently the only physician in Florida performing patient specific total knee replacement using MRI technology. A native of New York, Dr. Guttentag moved to Florida in 1992. He is married with three children.

Before your visit

When you schedule your appointment we will ask you to provide important information that will help us evaluate your current condition:

- ▶ A complete list of all medications
- ▶ All prior records including x-ray and MRI films
- ▶ Any and all records that refer to your condition

Services we provide in our office

- ▶ Basic on site x-ray
On site x-ray provides immediate diagnostic services. Our orthopaedic surgeons read and assess your films and develop a plan for your particular needs during your visit.
- ▶ Fracture Care
Includes applying and removing casts
- ▶ Post Operative care
Staple and suture removal, and dressing changes
- ▶ Pain Management Injections
- ▶ Joint Injections
Injections include but are not limited to, Supartz, Synvisc, Hyalgan, and Depo medrol



Patient Education

Each of our offices is equipped with a patient education area offering many resources for our patients including videos, printed material, and websites. These sources are available in addition to individual counseling provided by our physicians.

Coordinating your Surgery

Surgical procedures are performed in both in-patient and out-patient settings. Our Florida Medical Clinic Ambulatory Surgery Center is located on the first floor of our medical office building in Tampa, and is available for most of your outpatient needs. If your particular needs require a hospital stay, your surgery will be coordinated through our office.



Each physician has a designated Surgical Coordinator who will meet with you and organize your entire pre operative and post operative surgical care. Your surgical coordinator is your liaison between you and your physician. Services include:

- ▶ Scheduling surgery
- ▶ Providing educational materials
- ▶ Thorough review of the surgical process and care
- ▶ Coordinate pre-op and post-op clearances and appointments
- ▶ Assistance with insurance referrals and prior authorizations
- ▶ Coordinate home health and physical therapy
- ▶ Coordinate DME services, such as crutches and cold therapy

Winter Residents

Our staff is available to you during your visits to Florida in the winter months. Should you need special assistance during your stay, please contact our office so we may assist you in receiving care while you are in Florida.

Community Outreach

Our physicians provide sports medical services for local and professional sports teams in the Tampa Bay Area. Sports medicine physicals are also provided for local schools as well as physical therapy for local athletic programs.

What is Florida Medical Clinic?

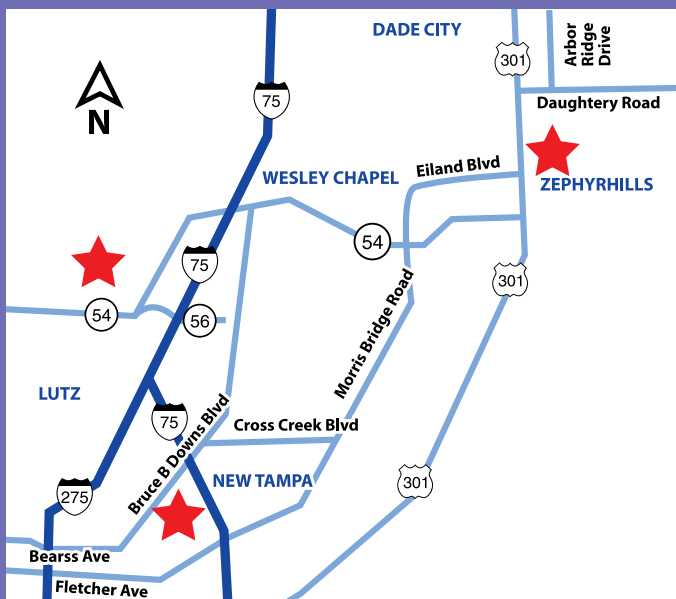
